

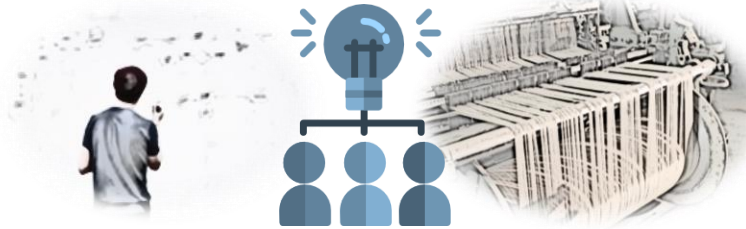

Advanced textiles materials sector is an emerging sector focusing on the technical aspects and contributions of textile materials rather than on the aesthetics. However, in order to foster the innovation, higher education systems need to bring in the creativity culture to textile engineering program in higher education as a way to unlock the innovation potential in advanced textile manufacturing industry.

In this context, DESTEX project will develop the tools necessary for skills enhancement targeted to higher education in relation to innovation in order to obtain its objectives.

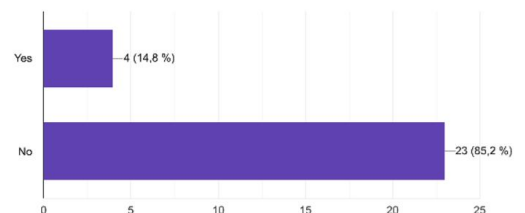
NEED ANALYSIS SURVEY RESULTS

This activity is key to determine the needs for the different outputs of the project including the summer course that will take place in 2021 in Milano.

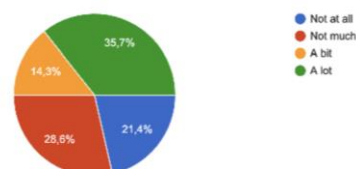
Do you think that the product and interior design curricula contain enough courses on textiles or advanced textiles?

VIRTUAL TRAINING PROGRAM

DESTEX partners are drafting the overall learning structure and major learning outcomes for the virtual training program. This will contain lectures and other open education resources for training higher education students with industrial and creative design tools applied in the advanced textiles' manufacturing.

SECOND CONSORTIUM MEETING

The second project meeting, scheduled on February 27th, was organized remotely due to current situation in order to review the overall project progress and to plan next activities.

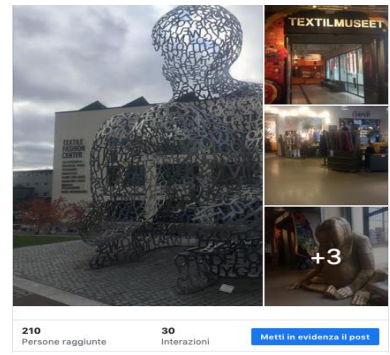
The main topics discussed includes the results of the need analysis survey that will guide the definition of the learning outcomes for the two training intellectual outputs: IO1 – Virtual training program and the IO2 – Book of lectures. Both IOs are progressing well, with the first macrostructure defined and agreed that will be further expanded in concrete products in the coming months.

During the meeting, a first mock-up of the virtual hackathon platform was shared among the partners in order to gather feedback and start developing it.

Next consortium meeting is scheduled for September 23th and 24th in Athens, Greece.

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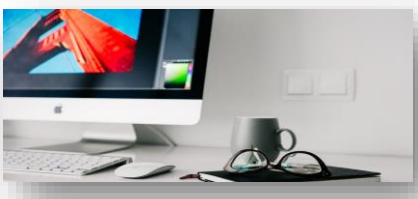
The kick-off meeting of DESTEX project was held on October 3rd and 4th. The project main objective is to promote the uptake of creativity culture as a catalyst to unlock the innovation potential in the advanced textiles' materials sector.

The meeting was held at the [University of Borås](#) in Sweden, as coordinator of the project. AEI Tèxtils, the Catalan Technical Textiles' Cluster, is one of the partners along with 6 more organizations: the design school [LCI Barcelona](#), the university [Politecnico di Milano](#), the Danish design school [Gulding](#), the Greek consulting firm [CSC The City](#), the training center [CACE](#) and the company [Material Conception Italia \(MCI\)](#).

The project officially started on September 1st, has a planned duration of 32 months, a budget of 318.676 € and is co-financed by the European Commission under the ERASMUS+ Programme within the strategic partnership for higher education action, with Grant Agreement 2019-1-SE01-KA203-060379.
